I am pleased to advise you that, based on a review of the documents and materials submitted in March 2008, on behalf of Operatives Plasterers and Cement Masons International Association, Local 500 & 600 and So. California Contractors Association, Inc., I have found the parties continue to meet the eligibility requirements of Labor Code section 3201.5.

This letter will permit you to continue to maintain an alternative dispute resolution system governing disputes concerning workers' compensation in compliance as outlined in the March 04, 2004, original letter of eligibility. Please submit a letter annually outlining any changes as provided by California Code of Regulations §10204(a). This letter is not a determination that the collective bargaining agreement itself, or any part of it is in compliance with Section 3201.5.

This letter of eligibility is effective April 1, 2008, the date of the expiration of the prior letter of eligibility and will expire on April 1, 2011.
