

Re: Laborers' Health & Welfare Trust Fund for Southern California Renewal of Eligibility

Dear Mr. Reinhardt,

Based on a review of the documents and materials submitted by Laborers' Health & Welfare Trust Fund for Southern California to renew eligibility to participate alternative workers' compensation system pursuant to Labor Code section 3201.5, it has been determined that eligibility is conditionally granted through February 28, 2021. This should provide sufficient time for us to work with you in order that all necessary reporting be completed. (See our letter dated May 19, 2020 and email dated July 3, 2020.)

This letter will permit you to continue to maintain an alternative dispute resolution system governing disputes concerning workers' compensation. It will also permit you to maintain an exclusive list of providers of medical treatment, medical evaluation, and vocational rehabilitation. This letter is not a determination that the collective bargaining agreement itself or any part of it is in compliance with Section 3201.5.

This letter covers the period beginning September 1, 2020, the expiration date of your previous letter of eligibility and will be valid until February 28, 2021, although it may become ineffective as to an individual employer on an earlier date, if that individual employer no longer carries the required insurance, or is no longer a signatory to a current section 3201.5 provision, or otherwise fails to meet the eligibility requirements of section 3201.5.
