I am pleased to advise you that, based on a review of the documents and materials submitted in March 2014, on behalf of the Southern California Contractors Association and the Operating Engineers Local 12, I have found the parties continue to meet the eligibility requirements of Labor Code section 3201.5. In the future, please apply for renewal of the letter of eligibility at least 30 days in advance of the expiration day of this letter of eligibility

This letter will permit you to continue to maintain an alternative dispute resolution system governing disputes concerning workers' compensation in compliance as outlined in the March 31, 1999, original letter of eligibility. Please submit a letter annually outlining any changes as provided by California Code of Regulations §10204(a). This letter is not a determination that the collective bargaining agreement itself, or any part of it is in compliance with Section 3201.5.

This letter of eligibility is effective April 1, 2014, the date of the expiration of the prior letter of eligibility and will expire on April 1, 2017.
