Dear Ms. Wells, Mr. Struthers and Mr. Sposito:

I am pleased to advise you that based on a review of the documents and materials received on February 1, 2016 I have found the parties eligible to continue to participate in a collective bargaining agreement under Labor Code Section 3201.5. The terms and conditions for continued eligibility, record keeping and reporting requirements outlined in the letter of February 2, 2010, remain in full force and effect. This letter is not a determination that the collective bargaining agreement itself, or any part of it is in compliance with Section 3201.5.

This letter covers a period beginning February 2, 2013, the expiration date of your previous letter of eligibility, and will be valid until February 2, 2019, although it may become ineffective as to an individual employer on an earlier date, if that individual employer no longer carries the required insurance, or is no longer signatory to a current 3201.5 provision, or otherwise fails to meet the eligibility requirements of Section 3201.5. Please submit a letter annually outlining any changes as provided by California Code of Regulations §10204(a) in addition to the required annual report.
