Re: Renewal of Letter of Eligibility: Laborers' Health & Welfare Trust Fund for Southern California

Dear Messrs. Sheh and Reinhardt:

I am pleased to advise you that, based on a review of the documents and materials submitted on February 4, 2021, I have found that the parties to this agreement continue to meet the eligibility requirements of Labor Code section 3201.5. The terms and conditions for continued eligibility, and recordkeeping and reporting requirements outlined in prior letters of eligibility remain in full force and effect. Please note this letter is not a determination that the collective bargaining agreement itself or any part of it is in compliance with section 3201.5.

This letter permits you to continue to maintain an alternative dispute resolution system governing disputes concerning workers' compensation. It also permits you to maintain an exclusive list of providers of medical treatment, medical evaluation, and vocational rehabilitation. As provided by California Code of Regulations, title 8, section 10204, subdivision (a), please submit a letter annually outlining any changes to your system.

This letter covers the period March 1, 2021, the expiration date of your previous letter of eligibility, to March 1, 2024. It may become ineffective as to an individual employer on an earlier date, however, if that individual employer no longer carries the required insurance, is no longer a signatory to a current section 3201.5 provision, or otherwise fails to meet the eligibility requirements of section 3201.5. Please note that during this eligibility period, you must submit annual reports and reporting data, each as required by regulation. (California Code of Regulations, title 8, sections 10204(a) and 10203.)
